UK terminology used
Pattern difficulty:
Moderate

Pattern sizes:
One size fits all

Measurements:
34cm wide x 73.5cm high (approx)

Circumference:
78cm (approx)

Materials:
Vinnis Colours Bambi :
4 balls of 88m/50g, DK in Slate
(840)
1 ball of 88m/50g, DK in Lime (809)
Hook: 4mm
Tapestry needle
Scissors

Tension:
18sts x 8 rows of pattern rep (Rows
1-3, ch 20 for swatch) = 10cm x 10cm

Abbreviations:

ch - chain
col - colour
dc - double crochet
puff st - puff stitch
rep - repeat
RS - right side
sk - skip
st - stitch
slst - slip stitch
tr - treble crochet
WS - wrong side
* - repeat from * x amount of times
yo - yarn over

Pattern notes:

To create a neat, gap-free edge do not replace the first treble of the treble rows with ch3. Instead ch2 and place the first treble into the very first stitch of the row.

Special stitches

Puff stitch:

yo, insert hook in next st, yo, draw yarn through st, yo, draw yarn through 2 loops on hook, twice in same st, yo draw yarn through 3 loops on hook.

To make:

With a 4mm hook and col Slate ch65.

Row 1 (RS):

Tr in third ch from hook, tr into next ch, *(sk next ch, tr in next ch) twice, tr in next ch, 5 tr in next ch, tr in each of next 2 ch, (sk 1 ch, tr in next ch) twice; rep from * across, tr in last ch, turn.

Row 2:

Ch1, dc in each tr across, turn.

Row 3:

Ch2, (tr into next dc) twice, *(sk next dc, tr in next dc) twice, tr in next dc, 5 tr in next dc, tr in each of next 2 dc, (sk 1 dc, tr in next dc) twice; rep from * across, tr in last dc, turn.

Rep rows 2-3 x8 (10 in total).

Cut yarn with sufficient length to weave in ends.

Row 1 (WS):

With a 4mm hook and col Lime, slst col to last tr, dc in each tr across, turn.

Row 2:

Ch2, (tr into next dc) twice, *sk next dc, puff st in next dc, sk next dc, tr in each of next 2 dc, 5 tr in next dc, tr in each of next 2 dc, (sk 1 dc, puff st in next dc) twice; rep from * across, tr in last dc, turn.

Rep rows 1-2 x3 (4 in total).

Cut yarn with sufficient length to weave in ends.

Row 1 (WS):

With a 4mm hook and col Slate, slst col to last tr, dc in each tr across, turn.

Row 2:

Ch2, (tr into next dc) twice, *(sk next dc, tr in next dc) twice, tr in next dc, 5 tr in next dc, tr in each of next 2 dc, (sk 1 dc, tr in next dc) twice; rep from * across, tr in last dc, turn.

Rep rows 1-2 x19 (20 in total).

Do not cut yarn.

To join:

Turn piece so WS is facing. Line up first and last row and slst into first ch of first row, dc into first tr of last row, continue alternating slst into next ch of first row and dc into next tr of last row all the way across. fasten off and sew in ends.

Turn cowl so RS is facing out.
