**Pattern sizes:**

Small/medium, (medium/large) (loose fit)

**Finished measurements:**

Bust:

130cm (140cm)

Length to shoulder:

55cm (60cm)

Sleeve length:

45cm (45cm)

**Materials:**

Vinnis colours Bambi:

14 (16) balls of 88m/50g DK

in Natural (800)

Needles: 7mm

Crochet hook: 5mm

Tapestry needle

Scissors

**Tension:**

Knitted in st st using 2 strands of  
yarn and 7mm needles

11 sts x 14 rows = 10cm x 10cm

**Abbreviations:**

beg - beginning

k - knit

k1p1 - knit 1, purl 1

p - purl

rem - remaining

st st - stocking stitch

st(s) - stitch( es)

WS - wrong side

**Pattern Notes:**

This sweater is knitted holding two  
strands of yarn together and using  
stocking stitch (knit 1 row, purl 1  
row).

**To make**

**Back panel:**

With 7mm needle and 2 strands of  
yarn held together, cast on 70 (80) sts.  
Work k2, p2 for 14 rows.  
Knit 62 (70) rows in st st.

**To shape neck:**

Knit 23 (28) sts, cast off 24 sts, knit  
23 (28) sts to end of row, turn.  
Purl back to neck edge.  
Cast off.

**Other side of neck:**

Re-join yarn to rem sts at neck  
edge (WS facing) and purl back to  
beg of row.  
Cast off.

**Front panel:**

With 7mm needle and 2 strands of  
yarn held together, cast on 70(80)  
sts.  
Work k2, p2 for 14 rows.  
Knit 52 (60) rows in st st.

**To shape neck:**

(To be knitted separately, keeping  
rem sts on the same needle).

Knit 35 (40) sts to middle of panel,  
cast off 2 sts, knit to end of row.  
Purl back to neck edge.  
Cast off 2 sts and knit row.  
Purl back to neck edge.  
Repeat the above two rows 4 times  
until 23 (28) sts remain.  
Cast off.

**Other side of neck:**

Re-join yarn to rem sts at neck  
edge (WS facing) and immediately  
cast off 2 sts, purl back to edge.  
Knit back to neck edge.  
Cast off 2 sts and purl back edge.  
Knit back to neck edge.  
Repeat the above two rows 4 times  
until 23 (28) sts remain.  
Cast off.

**Sleeves:**

With 7mm needle and 2 strands of  
yarn held together, cast on 26 (30) sts .  
Work k2, p2 for 14 rows.  
Knit 14 rows in st st.

Continue in st st but at the same  
time increase 1 st at the beg and  
end of the row every 6th row 9  
times (44 (48) sts).  
Purl 1 row.  
Cast off.

**To make up:**

Join the body panels at the shoulders.  
Measure 18 (20)cm from shoulder  
to attach sleeves.  
Sew sleeves to front and back.  
Sew side and sleeve seams.  
Also please note that the cuff of the  
sleeve is folded over.  
When making up the sweater make  
sure that the rib part of the sleeve  
is sewn inside out so that the seam  
doesn't show.  
Finish off neck by neatly crocheting  
around neck in treble crochet.  
Weave in ends.
